## St. Francis Hospice Dublin

### Who we are

The staff and volunteers of St. Francis Hospice provide specialist services across the City of Dublin and County. Our services are delivered from our hospices in Dublin City and County. In our philosophy, each person is treated with dignity, respect and compassion. Our services are at no charge to patients.

### What we do

We supported over 1200 patients and their families in 2014. Our team of Doctors, Nurses, Social Workers, Chaplains, Occupational Therapists, Lymphoedema Therapists, Care Assistants, Household, Administrative and Support Staff.

Specialist palliative care was provided to nearly 900 people in 2014 in our Centres in Raheny and Blanchardstown and patients also attended our Day Care Centres in Blanchardstown Hospice. In addition, 300 patients were provided with management and end of life care. We helped families both during and after bereavement by the Medical Social Work Team.

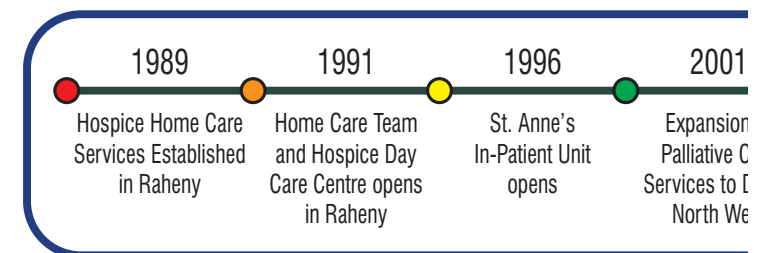
**Annually we need to raise €3.6 million to repay capital debt and to cover the shortfall in funding for St. Francis Hospice Dublin.**

### When and Where is the Draw Held?

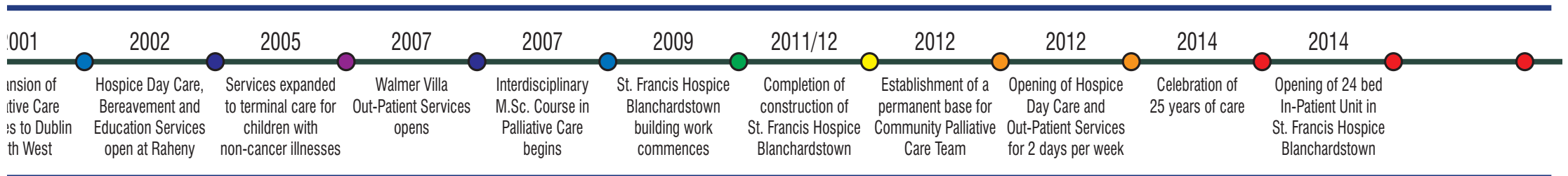
The Draw is held on the last Thursday of each month throughout the year at St. Francis Hospice, Raheny.

## Rules of the St. Francis Hospice Monthly Draw
